



Wonderful Summer School Opportunities

If your child struggles with concepts or classes, wants to remain academically alert, or wants to learn new skills in preparation for next school year, summertime is a great time to enroll in classes! The following teachers are available for private tutoring and/or group lessons at Holy Family Academy. Except for the class, **First Grade Readiness**, rates, dates, and times are negotiated with each individual teacher. The typical cost for private (one-on-one) tutoring is \$40 per hour while group rates depend on the number of students. Contact teachers individually to register for classes, check rates, dates of availability, and to ask questions about course content.
