



## *Tuition and Fees 2012-2013*

Tuition rates will be prorated according to enrollment quarter.

**Multi-Student Discount:** Holy Family Parishioners enrolling multiple students in PK through Grade 8:

- ✓ with 2 students will receive a **\$250** discount,
- ✓ with 3 students will receive a **\$700** discount,
- ✓ with 4 or more students will receive a **\$1,500** discount.
- ✓ There is no tuition charge for the 5<sup>th</sup> student and beyond.

### **Registration Fees:**

- ✓ **New families:** \$1,000 non-refundable registration fee per family; \$950 applied toward tuition
- ✓ **Returning families:** \$50 non-refundable fee per family; does not go toward tuition. *Most grade levels will have wait lists so families are encouraged to notify the school by the end of April if their enrollment status is going to change. Well-timed notification allows the school to plan staffing appropriately and permits access to students who may have otherwise been turned away.*

**School Fees:** School Fees are in addition to tuition and include the supplies and events listed here. In some cases where special projects occur, or there are unexpected expenses, students may be asked to provide additional supplies or pay an additional fee. School Fees pay for the following: an assignment notebook, paper, pencils, scissors, spiral notebooks, compasses, protractors, rulers, note cards, general art and technology supplies, classroom parties, Track and Field Day, Catholic Schools' Week, one field trip per student per year, the Thanksgiving Luncheon, the Academic Fair and Spring Program, the Rosary Pilgrimage, and the PTO fee. School Fees are non-refundable.

- ✓ **1st-8<sup>th</sup> grade students are assessed a \$125 fee**
- ✓ **Kindergarten students are assessed a \$100 fee**
- ✓ Pre-kindergarten students are assessed a \$50 fee.

**Payment Options:** Families must select one of the two options listed below:

- ✓ **Payment in Full:** Payment is due July 1<sup>st</sup>, 2012 or upon receipt if registering after July. A \$100 discount will be applied if paid on time. **ALL payments must be made through TADS - if you are paying your tuition in full in either 1 or 2 payments there is no charge for this from TADS.**
- ✓ **Installments:** Tuition that has not been pre-paid in full by July 1<sup>st</sup> before the start of the academic year must be paid by automatic withdrawal from your savings or checking account using TADS. Payments must begin in July and the tuition must be paid in full by the following July 1<sup>st</sup>. The use of TADS allows confidential, accurate tuition collection with flexible payment options. This system requires a one-time \$45 handling fee paid to TADS.

**Tuition Assistance:** Tuition Assistance is available for Parishioners\* of Holy Family Church. Distribution of funds is based on need and availability of funds. **The deadline for submitting an application is March 15<sup>th</sup>, 2012.** Applications are available online through TADS. Award notifications will be made by April 30, 2012.

**\*Parishioner:** Only Parishioners are eligible for tuition scholarship, tuition assistance, and multi-student discounts. The following guidelines will be used by Holy Family Academy to determine “parishioner” status:

- ✓ Registered members of Holy Family Church, for at least 1 year prior to the beginning of the school year (this can be waived with a letter from previous pastor)
- ✓ Regular Sunday Mass attendance at Holy Family Church
- ✓ Appropriate and verifiable stewardship to Holy Family Church
- ✓ Active participation in Holy Family’s volunteer & fundraising activities

**Fundraising:** Fundraising income is a significant component of Holy Family Academy’s operational budget. All families are expected to participate in the school fundraisers.

**Transportation Reimbursements from School Districts:** If your school district reimburses for transportation,

- ✓ Families that have paid their 2012-2013 tuition in full before the transportation reimbursement check is received by our accounting office will receive a check in the mail for the full amount of the reimbursement.
- ✓ Families that have not paid their 2012-2013 tuition in full before the transportation reimbursement check is received by our accounting office will not receive a check but the amount of the reimbursement will be applied to their TADS balance due.
